



Job Description Summer Raft Guide Temporary Seasonal

This position is a **temporary seasonal position** that will be active during the months of May 2023 to June 2023 working 2-4 days a week. The Raft Guide will support certain programs for our Therapeutic Adventure Program on the Rio Grande Racecourse. Therapeutic Adventure Programs are nature-based and focus on building community, effective conflict resolution, and self-regulation skills, play, creativity, building resilience, and connecting to nature.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Prepare and manage rafting gear.
- Meet and greet groups.
- Load and prepare rafts.
- Give safety speeches.
- Most importantly guide a safe and fun rafting trip.
- Ensures that all TMC policies and procedures are adhered to at all times.

Minimum Qualifications

- Minimum one season with a professional rafting company
- Experience on the Racecourse
- Swift water rescue experience preferred
- High school degree, equivalent or higher
- Experience working in group settings
- Ability to pass a criminal background check
- Clear driving record and valid driver's license with no restrictions

Work Environment: Working outdoors in varied weather conditions.

Hourly range is \$16-\$18 per hour depending on experience. Our work centers around people of color, individuals in recovery, and other marginalized communities. Therefore, we strongly encourage people with these identities and from these and other marginalized communities to apply.
