The NM Genders & Sexualities Alliance Network (NMGSAN) LGBTQ+ Outpatient Therapist position provides counseling services to individuals, families, or groups to address wellness and behavioral health needs with a primary focus in the NMGSAN program. The location for this role is in Santa Fe/Tesuque NM.

Clinical Therapist

Enrollment, Assessment and Evaluation:

- Prepare and maintain complete case files on all assigned clients, making sure that all required services, forms, and reports are included and complete.
- Perform assessments on clients utilizing ASAM levels of care (if applicable), biopsychosocial assessment and or other evaluation tools as assigned.

Treatment Planning:

- Assist clients in the development and implementation of their personalized, individual treatment plans, which address their self-identified co-occurring treatment issues. Client treatment plans will be executed using various treatment techniques and therapeutic counseling skills associated with established national treatment standards for the treatment of co-occurring disorders.
- Identify appropriate therapeutic interventions, modalities, or approaches that align with clients' needs...
- Set measurable goals and establish a timeline for therapy.

Individual Therapy:

- Conduct individual therapy sessions to work one-on-one with clients to address their specific needs.
- Provide individual, group, and family therapy, psycho-education cognitive/behavioral methods, motivational methods, CRA, or other therapeutic modalities as assigned.

Qualifications

- Master's level actively licensed in the state of New Mexico as a mental health/substance abuse Counselor or Therapist, LMSW, LISW, LMHC, LPCC, LSAA, LADAC, etc.
- NPI number and NM Medicaid number.

- Experience working with clients with co-occurring mental health and substance abuse assessment and diagnosis specifically with opioid-dependent clients.
- Experience providing individual and group psychotherapy.
- Ability to handle multiple priorities and work under pressure.
- Pass CYFD and other background checks.
- Familiarity with the social, cultural and economic make-up of New Mexico. Ability and willingness to work with diverse populations.
- Excellent written and oral communication and interpersonal skills.
- Working knowledge of standard office equipment (personal computer/laptop, phone with voicemail, fax, copier, etc.).
- Proficient in Microsoft Office including Word, Excel, Google Drive (g suite) as well as EMR databases.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience implementing therapeutic/clinical programming with a wide range of populations (LGBTQ+, Native American/Indigenous, Latino/Hispanic, etc).
- Bi-lingual/Bi-cultural (English/Spanish/other local languages).

The position provides 40 hours of work per week/weekends; salary range is \$50,000-\$62,000 annually depending on experience and qualifications. Paid Time Off and health insurance benefits are offered immediately, and retirement benefits offered after one year of employment. The Mountain Center is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
